

Coventry Little League House Rules 2011

1. Continuous batting order is to be used in all games.
2. All players are to play at least half of each game.
3. Coaches may coach both bases as long as there is an additional coach in the dugout.
4. Coaches are not allowed to warm up a pitcher.
5. Absolutely no on deck batters are allowed.
6. Pitchers are not allowed to throw curve balls or breaking balls.
7. No intentional walks and any pitcher that hits 3 batters within the game must be removed from that position.
8. Catchers mask must have a dangling throat guard.
9. Any player acting as a catcher on the field must wear a catcher's mask. This includes infield and outfield warm ups.
10. No hitting into the backstop.
11. Manager, one coach, and one scorer are allowed in the dugout with team.
12. With the exception of using the restroom players are not allowed to leave the dugout during games.
13. No eating with in the dugout with the exception of gum, sunflower seeds and drinks.
14. Both teams are responsible for providing someone for the concession stand and Home team is responsible for someone to run the score board. Visiting team is also responsible to have someone eighteen or older to keep track of the pitch count clicker. No games will begin until this is done.
15. Each team is to make sure dugout is swept clean and the garbage is emptied after each game.
16. Press box and concession stand must be locked up after each game.
17. Winning team must update the website including scores.
18. All warm ups must take place prior to game time so all games start on the scheduled time.
19. All players on third base must not advance beyond the pole during a possible bunt situation. Absolutely no slashing allowed.
20. Ten, eleven, and twelve year old pitchers mirror the Little League Rule Book.
21. If the home team is ahead, one team has a lead of 10 runs or more, then manager of the team with the least runs shall concede the

- victory to the opponent.
22. Coaches are allowed a pitcher conference three times but on the third visit the pitcher must be removed from the mound per game.
 23. Team A must prepare the field before the game and the Opponent team B must rake the field after the game.
 24. No stealing second on a walk as well as not advancing 2 bases on a walk.
 25. If a player arrives late for a game and his/her team has already batted one time thru lineup, that player is not eligible to play in that game. If the player arrives late for a game, and the team has not batted one time thru their lineup, the player will be placed in the last spot in the batting order and allowed to play.
 26. Any bases and any other equipment must be put away and locked up.

*** Note 1-Option 2(Pitchers league age 16 and under must adhere to the following rest requirements:

- if a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four(4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- if a player pitches 51-65 pitches in a day, three(3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- if a player pitches 36-50 pitches in a day, two(2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- if a player pitches 21-35 pitches in a day, one(1) calendar day of rest must be observed.
- if a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar days of rest is required.

Note 2- A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that game.

Note 3- Any player, who has played the position of catcher in four(4) innings or more in a game, is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day. The catcher cannot catch one thrown pitch in the fourth inning as it will count as an inning in that position, see above note.
